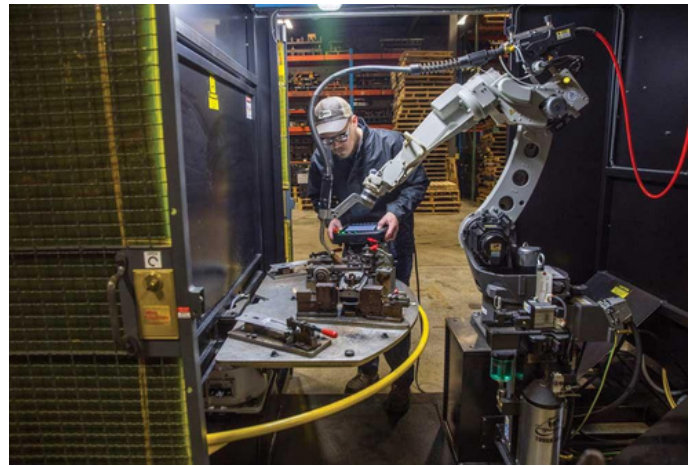
The American Welding Society (AWS) estimates that 330,00 new welding professionals will be needed by 2028. Robotic arm welder operators in particular are in high demand because a growing number of industries rely on automation to do business.

Entry-level robotic welder operators might earn **\$21 per hour or more**, with wages increasing with experience, additional training, and specialized certifications. The average salary for a robotic welder operator in Nebraska is **\$53,290 per year**.

Pathway to Robotic Welding

You can gain the skills you need to become a robotic welder operator in as little as a week, depending on the training program. Apprenticeships may also be available.

In addition to training, robotic welder operator should have strong attention to detail, the ability to quickly solve problems, and effective communication and collaboration skills. A high school diploma or GED may also be required.
