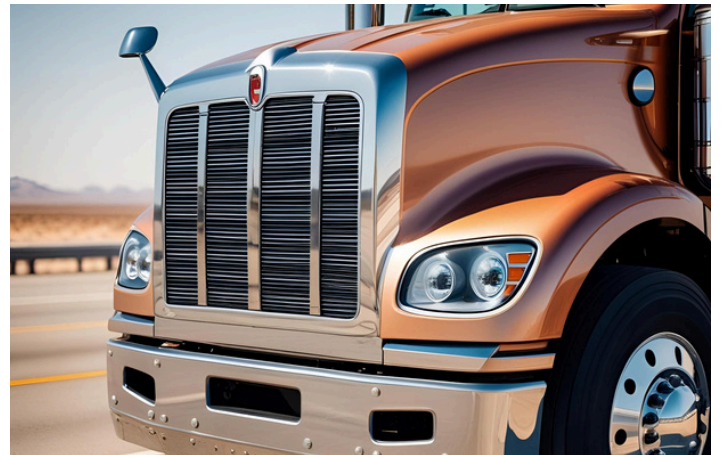
If you ever dream of hitting the open road while building a stable, well-paying career, becoming a CDL truck driver might be your perfect route.

The median salary for a truck driver in Nebraska is **\$57,940 per year**. This number can increase based on specialized roles or long-haul routes.

Pathway to Trucking

- Must be at least 21 years old for interstate operation
- Hold a valid Nebraska driver's license
- Receive a Commercial Learners Permit (CLP) at least 14 days before your CDL Exam
- Pass a skills test before applying for a CDL
